This name of Elam Christian Harvest Seminary was confusing many people due to unfamiliar of this word seminary to be used in Pentecostal Bible College especial in Tanzania. In September 01 the Directorate board of this Seminary decided to change a name of this institute from Elam Christian Harvest Seminary to Elam Christian University. Since September 03, 2020 this institute is known as Elam Christian University (in short ECU)

Elam Christian University is an Inter-denominational Higher Learning Institution (Bible Centered University) specialized in Equipping Servant Leaders and Workers for the End Time Harvest. ECU offers her courses in religious perspective . This is Bible centered Courses aiming in equipping Church Leaders with empowered by the Holy Spirit to reach the all nation with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

ECU is Pentecostal Christian Institution and receive the students from all Christian denominations within and outside Tanzania.

#### **15. QUALITY ASSURANCE UNIT**

- i. The Quality Assurance Unit acts as the central repository of the processes that underpin
- ii. the University's approach to the management of standards and quality education.
- iii. It details a range of procedures and codes of good practice that help to regulate the
- iv. University's approach to quality education assurance.



- v. Quality Assurance Unit contains a variety of guidance and advice that is commended to users to assist in the enhancement of quality and standards of teaching and learning activities at the university.
- vi. Quality Assurance Unit always aims at making ECU produce very competitive
- vii. Graduates as a result have formed quality assurance committees in each section, department, and faculty to oversee the delivery of quality teaching and other services. Thus, The primary objective of Quality Assurance Units
  - a. Enhancement of the quality of the teaching and learning experience and the Maintenance of academic standards at ECU. This is achieved through effective cooperation between academic and administrative staff and students
  - b. To set guidelines for Monitoring the effectiveness of its quality assurance procedures to assure that they are operating in accordance with good practice, in the best interests of students, staff and the community in the maintenance of academic standards.

## 16. GOVERNING BODIES

ECU is governed by the **Board of Trustees** as provided for in the University Constitution and Rules. The governing bodies of ECU include the **Council**, which is responsible for policy making, monitoring, and evaluation; and the **Senate**, which is responsible for all academic matters.

## 17. SCHOOLS

Elam Christian University has three schools established in order to supervise and coordinate studies in respective levels. Those schools are

### A. School of Continuing Education (SCE)

This school supervise and coordinate studies in a level of non degree studies such as Short courses, seminars and workshop, Basic certificate, Certificate Diploma and Advanced Diploma. This School is headed by the Dean of School. This school has the responsibility of ensuring that education provided to all programmes from this school has high quality and meet the need of the learner, church and society at large.

### B. School of Undergraduate Studies (SUS)

School of undergraduate studies supervise and coordinate all studies of undergraduate level which are the programmes of first Degree of Bachelor Degrees. All undergraduate level fall under this category. Undergraduate school is headed by the Dean of School. Is the function of this school to ensure the provision of higher quality education to the leaner so as to meet the demand of the learners, church and society in general

### C. School of Postgraduate Studies (SPS)

School of Postgraduate run studies from postgraduate Diplomas, Master's and Doctorate Degrees. All those level is under the school of Postgraduate studies. This School is also headed by Dean of School. This is the major school that produces the scholar or specialists in various Religious fields. This school is headed by the Dean of School.

## 18. DIRECTORATES

Elam Christian University (ECU) has different directorates which operate and supervise various activities. This directorates are Directorate of Information, Technology and Mass Communication, Directorate of Learning Centers', Directorate of Distance Learning, Directorate of Curriculum Development, Directorate of Literature and Publication, Directorate of Research and Consultancy.

#### **A. DIRECTORATE OF INFORMATION, TECHNOLOGY AND MASS COMMUNICATION**

This directorate deals with ICT issues, Public relation. It deals with supervision of all types of communication within the university and outside. This directorate has responsibility to ensure the good communication among the community member of the university. This Directorate stands as the university speaker/ information provider on behalf of the University Chancellor. Also has the responsibility of developing E-learning system in order to ensure smooth learning to students,

#### **B. DIRECTORATE OF CONSTITUENTS COLLEGES**

This Directorate has the responsibility to coordinate supervise and run all learning centres, Campus and Colleges under ECU. This directorate stand as the link or bridge between University HQ and campuses and Centres. Has the authority to establish or open learning Centre or a camps within and outside the Tanzania.

#### **C. DIRECTORATE OF DISTANCE LEARNING SYSTEM**

This directorate has the duty and responsibility to coordinate supervise and run the distance and open learning system. There are two department within this Directorate which are Department of Correspondence Studies and Department of Online Learning. This directorate ensure the quality of education offered by distance and open learning system.

#### **D. DIRECTORATE OF CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT**

This curriculum deals with preparing and developing all curriculums of all programmes offered by this university. This Directorate has the mandate to change a curriculum of particular programs on the recommendation of Senate upon the approval of University Council. Directorate of Curriculum Development is the heart of teaching and learning activities of the University.

#### **E. DIRECTORATE OF LITERATURE AND PUBLICATION**

This deals with writing and publishing books. Also deals with translating of various teaching and learning materials to be used by the university. This directorate makes teaching and learning materials available to be used by both learners and instructors.

#### **F. DIRECTORATE OF RESEARCH AND CONSULTANCY**

This directorate deals with conducting and supervising various researches, academic and developmental research. S also this directorate deals with proving various academic consultancies to ensure the whole personal development of learners.

### **19. DEPARTMENTS**

Elam Christian University has two types of department which academic Department and non Academic Department. All these academic work in close relation in order to bring the efficiency of the work done.

#### **A. NON ACADEMIC DEPARTMENT**

These are department which are not directly dealing with teaching and activities. They deal with the mainstreaming issues. These departments are

##### **i. FINANCE DEPARTMENT**

This is the Department that deals with financial matters. It corrects all payment from students and other source and take to bank. It keeps all financial records of income and revenue. This Department is lead by the University bursar assisted by Accountants and cashiers. This Department is under the Office of Deputy Vice Chancellor Finance, Planning and Administration (DVCFPA)

## iii. SECURITY AND DEFENSE DEPARTMENT

This deals with the security and defense. The function of this department is to ensure the security and the defense. To ensure that the whole community member of Elam Christian University and their property are self. This department should have the staff who are trained in security and defense Matters. This department also is under the office of Warden of University.

## iv. MEALS AND ACCOMODATION DEPARTMENT

This department is responsible for supervising issues related to meals and accommodation of students. All on campus students must have a proper means of getting meals and accommodation whether within a university campus or nearby university campus. The meals and accommodation of students should maintain students' health so that they can get well education pursued at this university. There must be a cafeteria at the university. There should be good dormitories/Hostels for both male and female students. This department is under the office of Warden of University.

## B. ACADEMIC DEPARTMENT

## 20. SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE FUND

This is a special fund established in order to assist students who comes from vulnerable environment. Those students who have hard life and fail to get opportunity of joining with this university may get the scholarship assistance which may cover a half or all cost of studies. ECU Council will find donors from within and outside the country who will donate in this fund so that to enable sponsorship activities. In order to get this scholarship applicant must prove that she/he is coming from poor environment and she/he is unable to pay a tuition fee.

Any student who need scholarship is ought to apply through a dean of students/deputy Vice Chancellor Academic. An applicant of scholarship should follow instruction written in the ECU scholarship Assistant Fund Book.

## 21. LEARNING MODES

Elam Christian University (ECU) offers training through on campus learning system and off campus learning system. We offer studies by face to face whereby students attend in the class at our campuses. Colleges and learning centre's. On campus learning is where by instructors and students interact together. Students attend in the class regularly as planned by the university.

Elam Christian University conducts training through various learning centre and campus open in whole over the country and outside the country. Student can join with this university through our learning centre nearby his/her resident. Since that we have many learning centre's almost in every region. Now we plan to have learning centre's in every district and in every city. Student who want to study at our head quarter is welcome, though it is not necessary since that the same courses/programmes offered at main campus/head quarter is the same we offer in our campuses and learning centre's.

Through off campus training Elam Christian university offers her training through distance learning system. Off campus learning is offered through correspondence and e-learning or online learning. Off campus training almost students interact with learning materials. Students also can interact with instructor through technology such as social media (emails, whatsapp, youtube, Zoom meeting cloud etc). Now ECU is developing moodle learning system whereby online students will use that learning system to learn.

ECU offers studies through correspondence studies through posts (masomo kwa njia ya posta) books and exams are sent to students through posts or correspondence.

On campus students to not need to move from one place to another for learning all things are take there where they are through internet and correspondence.

Student can study from certificate to doctoral from all through correspondence, online or through face to face.

Online and correspondence students takes open examination, they are given learning materials (books) and exam. Students are allowed to use materials in doing examination. While on campus students take both open and closed examination depending on the nature of course.

In short we offer studies through three systems face to face, (on campus), online and correspondence. Online and Correspondence students study at their own pace.

## 22. ADMISSION PROCEDURES

## 23. **ACADEMIC CALENDAR**

The academic calendar is organized into semesters. Courses are coded by level of academic progression and are assigned credits. Each course is examined at the end of the semester.

## 24. **DAILY CLASS SCHEDULE**

Classes start from 08.00 hours to 15.30 hours from Monday to Saturday ; and No classes on Sundays and public holidays shall be conducted unless it is agreed between class members and the Course Instructor.

3.3. Elective Courses These courses shall be graded in the same manner as core or compulsory courses.

## 25. **ACADEMIC INTEGRITY**

The academic community of ECU believes that one of the goals of a Christian institution of higher education is to strengthen academic integrity and responsibility among its members. To this end, the University emphasizes the importance of sound judgment and a personal sense of responsibility in each student. All members of the academic community are expected to respect the highest standards of academic integrity.

Academic dishonesty is a serious offence at ECU because it undermines the bonds of trust and personal responsibility between and among students and faculty, weakens the credibility of the academic enterprise, and defeats those who believe in the value of academic integrity. Academic dishonesty can take several forms:

- i. **Cheating** – Intentionally using or attempting to use unauthorized materials, information, or study aids in any academic exercise (test, exercise, etc.)
- ii. **Fabrication** – Intentional and unintentional
- iii. **Falsification** or intention of falsification of any information or citation in an academic exercise.
- iv. **Facilitating academic dishonesty** – intentionally or knowingly helping or attempting to help another student commit a breach of academic integrity.
- v. **Plagiarism** – representing the words or ideas of another as one's own in any academic exercise.
- vi. A student who commits an act of academic dishonesty shall be dismissed from the University for a period of not less than three years.

## 26. **INCOMPLETE WORK**

Students who do not complete assigned work by the end of the semester shall not be allowed to sit for end of semester University Examinations (UE), and shall be required to carry over the course in the prospective semester when the course is offered. If a student has more than four incomplete works shall be dismissed from the University. Exceptions will be made only in extenuating circumstances.

A student shall be allowed to sit for University examinations after passing the course work by getting 20 marks or above of the course work. Equally, a student shall be considered to have passed the University examinations if he/she gets marks of not less than 20. Any less than 20 marks in the university examination will lead —*technical* supplementary.

### Promotion to Next Academic Year

a. For promoting the student to the next academic year, average GPA shall be calculated on annual basis by taking into consideration the two academic semesters. Additionally, a student must pass both the Course Work and the University Examinations by the set limits by getting not less than 20 marks in each category (CW and UE) otherwise the student shall have to make up the difference by sitting for the supplementary Examinations.

- b. Candidates with Ds will do supplementary Examinations and with Es shall carry over the course/s. A candidate who attains Ds and has an average GPA of 1.8 or more shall sit for supplementary examinations.
- d. A candidate who attains Ds and has an average GPA of less than 1.8 at the end of the academic year shall repeat a year. A candidate who attains Ds or Es and has an average GPA of equal or less than 1.0 at the end of the academic year shall be discontinued from studies at the University.
- e. Candidates are required to pass in all the courses of the examination at the end of semester before proceeding to the following academic year.
- c. If a student gets the minimum average of below 35 percent, which is an 'E' in more than four courses in the final assessment she/he shall not be promoted to the next academic year. She/he shall repeat the year or be discontinued from studies depending on the GPA.

**27. DISCONTINUATION FROM STUDIES**

Students will be discontinued from any course programme because of the following:

1. Failure to attend scheduled examinations, unless caused by extenuating circumstances.
2. Failure to pass scheduled examinations due to,
  - a. Examination irregularities.
  - b. Failure to pay student Tuition fees, deposits, and charges.
  - c. Disciplinary offence as described in the —ECU By Lawsl.
  - d. Health problem as recommended by a competent medical Practitioner and approved by the University.
  - e. The year's overall average GPA equal or below 1.0 3.
3. Students who have been discontinued from a programme on the grounds of inadequate academic performance may reapply to the programme only if:
  - a. Two years have passed since their discontinuation;
  - b. They can prove evidence of their efforts to improve their academic standing;
4. Participation in demonstration of any sort without the permission of the Vice Chancellor;
5. Involvement in any illegal issue which is against the law of the United Republic of Tanzania.
6. Doing a sin and refuse to repent

Discontinued students on academic grounds can only be readmitted once.

**28. GRADING SYSTEMS**

In order to graduate, students shall be required to take all courses required in the respective programme. The amount of courses to be taken by a student is shown in each program of study.

**29. GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)**

Courses shall be weighted by multiplying the points associated with the final grade of a given course by the number of credit hours assigned to the course. A candidate's overall performance is then found by dividing the weighted credit points of all courses taken by the total number of course credit hours.

30. **UNIVERSITY PASS MARKS**

ECU has two modes of assessment and evaluation which are formative and summative. Formative deals with course work (CW) while Summative deals with University Examination (UE)

Course work consist of 50 marks. Pass mark of course work is 30 out 50. If student score a course work below 30 she/he will not be allowed to sit for university examination and will carry a course up to next academic year.

University Examination consist of 50 marks. In order to get a total marks of a course. Take CW+UE = total course marks.

The maximum pass is 100 marks while the minimum pass is 60 for Undergraduate, and PGD's and non Degree Programmes. While The Postgraduate Degrees the maximum is 100 and Minimum is 71 marks

31. **RESEARCH WRITING**

**RESEARCH FOR UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE AND POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA**

Each academic Programme ought to have a course in Research Methods and Research. Each Undergraduate and PGD student is supposed to undertake **ONE** research project during the studies in their related subject under supervision.

During the 5<sup>th</sup> for undergraduate and 2<sup>nd</sup> for PGD semester, students will be required to undertake a detailed research project on selected research topics. The research topics will be provided by the respective heads of departments in collaboration with the course instructors. The research reports shall be submitted at the end of the respective semester. If offered in the 5<sup>th</sup> semester, it ought to be submitted at the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> semester prior to beginning of the other semester.

Research is to be written by using Times New Roman, double space 12 font size. Citation and referencing should be in APA or MLA style.

Undergraduate and Postgraduate Diploma research work should have a minimum 60-100 pages excluding preliminary information. Student must submit a hard copy and soft copy in CD/DVD.

Undergraduate students are to submit their research to the undergraduate school through their supervisor.

32. **EXAMINATION RULES AND REGULATIONS**

a. **Eligibility for Examinations**

- i. All students should adhere to attendance policy of Elam Christian University. It is important that a student attend classes both physically and mentally. Studying the texts and the lecture/presentations/practicals/tutorials are the keys to success.
- ii. Students must have attended a minimum of eighty percent (80 percent) of their scheduled class period for each course and have completed all course requirements.



- iii. A candidate shall be barred from doing the examinations if the school Dean or course instructor is not satisfied with the attendance of that candidate or the candidate has not passed the Course Work by getting a mark of not less than 20 marks out of 30 or of the course work.
- iv. The Deputy Vice Chancellor Academic in consultation with the Dean of Students, the school Dean, Head of Department and the course instructor may, in extenuating circumstances, waive the attendance requirements for a student.
- v. If a candidate who has been barred because of unsatisfactory attendance enters the examination room and sits for the paper, her/his results shall be invalidated or nullified.
- vi. Students shall be allowed to sit for examinations only after payment in full of all fees.
- vii. Any student who would not sit for the examination without any reason shall be discontinued from studies.
- viii. Any student who sits for examination without finishing the tuition fee, his/her examination result shall be nullified and be required to resit for the examination as special examination upon payment of penalty of Tshs. 100,000.00/

## **Conducting of Examinations**

### **A. Notes to Candidates/Students**

1. Candidates **shall** have tutorial, take home assignments, and tests marks to make up the coursework.
2. Candidates **shall** be allowed to sit for examinations only after payment of **all** fees.
3. Candidates **shall** be allowed to sit for examinations only if he/she has done coursework and obtains 20 out of 30 marks.
4. . Every candidate **shall** make sure that he/she is issued with an examination number before the beginning of the examinations.

Each candidate **shall** be responsible for noting any changes taking place in the examination timetable.

5. The candidates **shall** be at the examination room 30 minutes before starting the examination.
6. No candidate **shall** enter an examination room before identification and permission to enter.
7. No candidate **shall** be allowed to enter the examination room 30 minutes after the starting time.
8. No candidate **shall** be allowed to leave the examination room 10 minutes before the ending of examination session.
9. No candidate **shall** be allowed to leave the examination room temporarily (e.g. to toilet) without an escort when the examinations are in progress.
10. All candidates **shall** be required to sign the attendance register.
11. Candidates **shall** be required to observe any general instructions that may be given by an invigilator and to note carefully any instructions that appear at the head of the examination paper, such as those indicating the number of questions to be attempted.
12. Examinations **shall** be held on the dates shown on the timetable and all papers shall be sat on the time specified. Any changes shall be communicated to students.
13. The duration of the question papers, shall be the time shown on the paper **shall** have to be followed where contradictions arise.
14. No candidate **shall** be allowed to bring unauthorized material into the examination room. In this regulation; **“Unauthorized material”** includes:
  - i. Any hand written or printed material
  - ii. Crib notes (answers)
  - iii. Cellular or mobile phones
  - iv. Radios
  - v. Radio cassette or other types of cassette players

- vi. CD players
- vii. VCD/DVD
- viii. Computers
- ix. Alcoholic drinks, drugs
- x. Purses, bags
- xi. Jackets, coats, -*Mitandio*”, -Kanga, -*Kitenge*, all forms of clothes assisting in hiding unauthorized materials
- xii. Programmable calculators
- xiii. Any other materials as may be specified by the University authorities from time to time

15. No candidate **shall** be allowed to borrow examination tools/materials such as pens, calculator, correction fluid, rubber, ruler, etc. from another candidate during the examination. **Borrowing from others is interpreted as cheating and is therefore NOT allowed.** Where borrowing is necessary, the candidate **shall** strictly communicate with the invigilator.

16. Leaving the examination room to look at pre-hidden notes is a breach of examination rules and regulations.

17. Before leaving the examination room, every candidate shall make sure that the top cover of the answer book is filled properly.

### **Examination Performance**

1. Non Degree and PGD students who earn below grade C in their courses shall be allowed to take supplementary examinations in any semester in those courses before the start of the next semester or as deemed convenient.
2. A postgraduate Students who earn below B of their courses shall be allowed to take supplementary examinations in any semester in those courses before the start of the next semester or as deemed convenient
3. Students failing in not more than 4 courses in any one academic year shall be required to supplement, provided the overall GPA is not less than 1.8. Supplementary examinations will be marked out of 70.
4. Students who sit for the supplementary examinations shall be awarded grade C, D or E.
5. Students who fail the supplementary examination shall repeat the course (carry-over) while continuing with the programme and will have to clear them in the following academic year. Carry-over course shall be charged a carry-over fee.
6. A Carry-over Non degree and PGD student who attains a D mark will not sit for a supplementary examination but will carry over the course again.
7. A Carry-over Postgraduate Degree student who attains a C mark will not sit for a supplementary examination but will carry over the course again.
8. A passed carried over course shall be awarded not more than a C credit for non degree, undergraduate and PGD and B to Postgraduate Degree Students.
9. A Student who fails a carried over courses shall carry over the course again.
10. First year students who achieve below grade C or B depending a level for more than four of their courses shall repeat a year and if they fail the repeated courses, they shall be discontinued from the University.
11. Second year students who achieve below grade C and B depending a level of or more of their courses shall be required to repeat all courses, which were not passed with grade D or higher in the next academic year. If they fail the repeated courses, they shall be discontinued from the University.

12. Third year students who fail the carried over courses or supplementary examinations shall undertake them as external candidates. The external candidates shall have to complete all requirements for the course and sit for the end-of-semester University examinations. No carried-over course shall be undertaken more than once. Then discontinuation from studies will follow. A payment of **Tshs. 100,000.00** shall be charged per course and all other fees; registration, examination and Student Union fees.

12. All carried over courses shall be cleared within the allowable maximum period of registration otherwise; the student shall be discontinued from studies. The maximum period of registration is five years (ten semesters).

13. Admission to another programme shall be subject to the approval of the Senate and upon payment of programme charge fee.

15. Students may repeat a course once in a semester. The maximum grade that shall be awarded for a passed repeated course shall be C or B depending a study level of student

16. Students are advised to request for Provisional Statement of examination results in order to avoid any inconveniences.

### **Special Examinations**

1. A student may in extenuating circumstances postpone sitting for an examination in the following cases:-

a. Illness or any other reason such as death of spouse parent and child. Provided and substantiated in writing, by an authorized medical practitioner.

b. All requests to sit for special examinations shall be presented to the school Deans who will channel them to the DVCA.

c. And that, the Deputy Vice Chancellor for Academic A has approved the reason.

2. Any student who fails to sit for normal examinations can sit for **SPECIAL** examinations after the submission of special examination request form stating the reasons before the examination period elapses. A **Special Examination Request Form** shall be used in submitting the request.

3. When a student is allowed to sit for special examinations, she/he shall be considered to be attempting the examination for the first time, and shall be accorded all of the rights provided in the examination regulations.

4. All students planning to sit for special examination shall register with the respective school deans and pay a special examination fee, which is Tsh. 50,000/ prior to the examinations.

5. No supplementary examination should be issued as a result of sitting for special examination.

### **Examination Irregularities**

1. Inappropriate conduct by a student concerning final examinations impairs academic integrity, and therefore, will subject the offending student to expulsion. Such examination irregularities include but are not limited to:

Viewing examination questions prior to sitting for the exams.

i. Possessing of unauthorized material in the examination room.

ii. Beginning the exam before being authorized.

iii. Attempting to copy or referring to unauthorized materials in the examination room.

iv. Reading another student's answers.

v. Communication with other students verbally or through other means, during the

- examination without permission from the invigilator.
  - vi. Permitting another student to copy from or use one's paper.
  - vii. Obtaining, or endeavoring to obtain, assistance from any other student directly or indirectly or endeavoring to give assistance to any other student.
  - viii. Removing examination answer books/sheets from the examination room.
  - ix. Continuing the exam after being ordered to stop.
  - x. Failing to comply with examination rules, regulations or directions given by an invigilator.
  - xi. Destroying or attempting to destroy evidence relating to any suspected irregularity.
  - xii. Any other action which might be noted by invigilators
2. If an invigilator suspects a student of examination irregularities, the following steps should be taken.
- The student to be approached immediately.
    - All improper materials to be confiscated and the student not to be allowed to continue with the examination.
    - The Student shall submit a written statement to the school Dean within twenty four hours, not later than the following day
    - The Chief invigilator and the examination officer should present a filled form and written report of the incident to the school Dean who shall forward the matter to the Deputy Vice Chancellor Academic. The form should be fully signed by the candidate.
  - The Examination report together with the student's written statement and examination Irregularities Allegations Form shall be considered by the investigation committee of the Academic Board. The recommendations from the Investigation committee shall be forwarded to the Academic Board which shall report to the Senate.
3. If it is established by the Academic Board and approved by the Senate that a student committed an irregularity, then the student shall be expelled from the University for a period of two Academic years.

### **Release of Examination Results**

Results of all candidates in every final semester examination shall be subject to review by the Academic Board and approval by the Senate. Public disclosure of the examination results shall be made following the approval by the Senate. Results shall be published and released to the students through the University notice boards and by the Deputy Vice Chancellor Academic identifying the student by Examination number and the grades obtained by each candidate. The results shall also be posted on the Elam Christian University y and/or through the mobile phones.

### **Procedure for Appeal**

1. All appeals must be presented to the school Deans by filling examination appeal forms. Faculty Deans shall channel them to the Deputy Vice Chancellor Academic (DVCA) before the supplementary examinations or within fifteen (15) days of publication of the examination results, or within fifteen (15) days of the first day of class of the next academic period, whichever is later. The appellant shall pay non-refundable fee of Tshs. 20,000/= . All appeals should be channeled through the respective school Deans by filling in the appeal form.
2. Academic appeals shall be considered only on matters of procedure, competency and/or prejudice
3. The Deputy Vice Chancellor Academic shall submit the appeals to the Academic Board, who shall appoint a competent sub-committee to handle any appeals received during that semester. The findings and recommendations of the sub-committee shall be forwarded to the Academic Board, which shall give a provisional decision, pending the University Senate's approval.

1. The University administration shall have the power to require any appellant to bear the costs of any special investigation. Such detailed investigation and associated costs will be disclosed in advance and agreed upon by the appellant and the University administration.
2. Each student is responsible for the released examination results. No candidate shall be considered on an incomplete case with an argument of not receiving or seeing the examination results.
3. All appeals shall be concluded before the completion of the following Academic semester and no allowance shall be considered thereafter.
4. Any candidate who is not satisfied with the given examination results, has the right to apply for the remarking of the examination paper of the given course. The candidate shall pay a non-refundable fee of **Tshs. 10,000 per course** for remarking the examination.
5. Also all students are reminded to clear all their incomplete cases within the given academic year. Any extension shall mean carrying over the course.

### 33. **ALMINIE**

There will be the conference of all graduate from this university. This conference will be held after three years. All graduate will be invited to attend this conference. The office of Dean of students will be responsible for administration of graduate conference known as alminie conference.

### 34. **PRESERVATION OF EXAMINATION PAPERS**

The University shall preserve student's examination papers for the purpose of reference for a period of three (3) years. The Chancellor on the recommendation of the DVCA shall be responsible to order final disposal of any batch of examination answer booklets. Hence, students cannot appeal after lapse of this period.

### 35. **ACADEMIC PRIZES**

#### **i. Academic Prize for Students**

Academic prizes shall be offered to students with outstanding academic performance during the whole programme. For the ECU Academic Prize, this will apply to a student with highest overall GPA. The nature of the prizes will be dictated by the availability of funds.

#### **ii. Academic Prizes for Academic Staff**

Academic prizes shall be offered to the academic staff with an outstanding performance in the academic issues. This might include publications in a journal or in a book form. The prizes will be dictated by the availability of funds.

### 36. **LATE COLLECTION FEE FOR ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPT AND CERTIFICATE.**

The collection of academic transcript and certificates after 2 one month of release a student will pay 20,000/ per month as a certificate storage fee

### 37. **ORIENTATION FOR NEW STUDENTS**

This is held in the week before the first semester begins. Activities include addresses by the University Authorities and meetings with school Deans as well as Heads of Departments. Students are also exposed to existing rules and regulations in force at the University.

### 38. STUDENTS' ORGANIZATION

There is a central government of the student's body called Elam Christian University Students Organization (ECUSO), which promotes and safeguards the interests of all students. This organization is the major link between the University administration and the students. It has a parliament with an elected speaker, and ministers as well as deputy ministers in selected areas under the President, Vice-President, Prime Minister and General Secretary.

### 39. CAMPUS SECURITY

Unauthorized persons in or near the halls of residence or present on campus or (any other dangerous conditions) should be reported immediately to campus security officers.

### 40. DRESSING

ECU is training prospective teachers, pastors, and leaders. In terms of dressing, it means that decent and modest dressing shall be adhered to. Immoral and inappropriate dressing by students shall lead into disciplinary actions, ranging from suspension to dismissal from the University. Dressing in uniform of any political party is strictly prohibited.

### 41. GENDER VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL HARASSMENT

Gender violence and sexual harassment is against the human rights of a person. Hence, any student who will be involved in such inhuman activities of any sort shall not be tolerated. Strict disciplinary measures shall be undertaken against the student.

### 42. VIOLATION OF POLICIES

Violation of these or any other University policies can result in disciplinary actions, including expulsion from the residence rooms as well as from the University. The student on disciplinary penalty should not hold or run for any elected or appointed position;

### 43. ABIDING TO STUDENTS' BY-LAWS

All students are advised to be acquainted and to abide with Students' By-Laws

### 44. CASES TO COURT AND POLITICAL ISSUES

Once a student is having a case or suspected to have committed a crime/ Shall be suspended from studies at the university until the issue is settled by the parties concerned.

### 45. DISCIPLINARY PROBATION

Any student on disciplinary probation shall not hold or run for any elected appointment positions.

#### A) A student of ECU shall NOT:

- i. Engage in political activities on campus or while on campus,
- ii. Wear uniforms of any political party on campus or while on campus, by words or acts, bring the University or the Government into dispute based on his/her political belief or affiliation.
- iii. Use the name of the University for any document without official permission.

### 46. SPOKESPERSON OF THE UNIVERSITY

The Chancellor (UC) is the only spokesperson who can allow the media on campus. A person who calls a media or report on the University issues without the consent of the Chancellor shall be subject to disciplinary action. The disciplinary action shall be either suspension or dismissal from studies.

### 47. CHANNELING OF ISSUES BY STUDENTS

Students ought to channel their issues through EUSO organs, which are under the leadership of the EUSO President. After that they may channel to Dean of Students

#### 48. POSTPONING STUDIES

Students may postpone studies due to various reasons such as illness, fee problems etc. student who wish to postpone studies will fill the studies postpone form available to dean of students. After filling that form will be channeled to Deputy Vice Chancellor Academic for Permission. Students will suppose to pay amount of TSH, 30,000 (\$20) as a process of studies postpone form.

Student may postpone studies up to three years. After coming back to studies student will begin where he/she ended when he postponed studies.

#### 49. DISCONTINUES FROM STUDIES

**Student can be terminated from studies due to the following reasons**

- i. Examinations irregularities
- ii. Violating university rules and Regulations
- iii. Failure to attend class for four months without permission
- iv. Earning low GPA (1.6 and below )
- v. Death

#### 50. FINANCIAL MATTERS

##### **Policy on Payment of Tuition Fees**

- i. Each student must complete the fee payment agreement and file it with the Bursar.
- ii. A student is not allowed into any lecture or tutorial session without being registered with the University.
- iii. Any student attempting to attend classes or access any other University facility without paying fees, is subject to expulsion.
- iv. Any student who shall indulge in forgery of university payments shall be dismissed from the university.
- v. Tuition fees once paid is not refundable.
- vi. All those requiring refund should keep their receipt.
- vii. All refunds shall be paid back after completion studies

### UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMMES

Elam Christian University offers different programmes in bachelor degree level. These programmes have national and International level. Bachelor degree Programmes are the First Level Degree in series which prepares students to enter in full professional ministry.

Undergraduate Degree programmes produce different scholars and experts in Ministry and other field in integrated Degree programmes such as Bachelor of Theology with Leadership, Bachelor of Theology with Management and Administration, Bachelor of Theology with Psychology etc.

#### Entry qualifications

In order to be admitted in the Bachelor Degree programmes an applicant must have the following qualifications

- i. A born again Christian
- ii. A member of a local church
- iii. Must be recommended by his/her church leader
- iv. Must have age of 18 and above
- v. Holder of Advanced Certificate of secondary Education or equivalent to it with at least two principals and one subsidiary passmark
- vi. Or a holder of a Diploma in any field with at least 3.0 GPA
- vii. Able to pay tuition fee
- viii. Able to follow university regulations and by-laws

#### Programmes Structure

Bachelor degree Programmes are programmes which are offered to both fresh students and up grading students. Fresh students from Secondary school will take 45 course modules which makes 135 total credits unit. While a upgrading student with Diploma will take 35 courses modules which makes 105 total credits unit. While and applicant with other degree will take 27 course modules which makes 81 total credit units.

Student will take two field study during the programme. And write one Research paper or for those with other degree will be allowed to transfer their results from other degree to the ECU degree Programme. In order to transfer the research credits student must apply to the DVCA and pay a required fee of Research and Transfer fee. Student must have passed a research with at Least B grade.

#### **Instructions**

Bachelor of Theology with Church Leadership is a programme of study designed to equip church Ministers and Servant leaders for effective ministry and the harvest for end time this programme is intended to give knowledge and skills on Bible, Theology ministry and Leadership skills in order to enable church leaders and minister to perform well their call in serving Gods purpose on earth

Bachelor of Theology with Church Leadership is intended to eliminate the shortage of church ministers with leadership skills and knowledge. Students are trained spiritually, mentally and physically in order to carry ministerial duties

After completing the bachelor gree of Theology with Church Leadership a student will be able to perform various ecclesiastical duties according to the call of each one.

This is a curriculum for students who have Certificate/ Advanced certificate of secondary Education (CSE/ACSE), Diploma holder in Theology or who have earned other degree or secular degree and wants to pursue the Bachelor Degree of Theology. This program is known as the Second Degree (2nd BA) to those with the first Degree. Students with a Diploma in Theology or equivalent to it and those with the Secular Bachelor Degree must take 25 courses. The form four and Six leavers and secular Diploma will take 48 courses plus one research. For form and form six leavers will take the entry examination in order to be eligible for pursuing the Bachelor Degree of Theology. Applicant with unclassified Diploma in Theology its equivalent will also take the entry examination. The minimum score of entry examination is 60 marks. Applicant who fails to get 60 marks will not be allowed to pursue a Bachelor Degree instead will be allowed to study the Advanced Diploma in Theology.

Bachelor Degree of Theology with Church Leadership is a program of study that is offered four years for fresh students and two year for upgrading students. Students may take studies for less than duration of time mentioned above in special cases

#### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

In order to blue admitted to pursue this programme of study students must have the following qualifications:

- i. A born gain Christian
- ii. Have 21 Years and above
- iii. Diploma holder in Religious Education or equivalent to it with at least 3.0 GPA
- iv. Certificate of Secondary Education or advanced Certificate of Secondary Education
- v. Bachelor Degree Holder

## 4. BACHELOR OF THEOLOGY WITH PSYCHOLOGY (BTP)

### Instructions

Bachelor of Theology with Psychology (BTP) is a program of study designed to equip church Ministers in area of Bible, Theology and Psychology. This programme is very important in contemporary society due to various challenges that encounter Christian followers and the whole society in general

This program is intended to produce Christian Psychologist who will serve as church Ministers as well Psychologist. After graduating this program it is expected that students will work as church pastors, church Counselors and other ministries depending the ministry and gifts of students. The graduates will work in para -church organization to serve to church followers and the whole society in general.

This programme provides knowledge and skills in Bible, Ministry, Theology, arts, Leadership and Psychology. Students are taught in all aspects in order to enable them to perform well the teaching Ministry.

### PROGRAMME DURATION.

Bachelor of Theology with Psychology is a four years programme of study to fresh students and two years for upgrading students. Online students have no limit of minimum time due to their system of learning since that distance learning students learn at their own pace.

Diploma and Bachelor Degree holder will take 35 plus Research only. Fresh students will take 48 courses to earn a Bachelor Degree of Theology with Psychology (BTP) of Elam Christian University (ECU). Students will take all core courses and select some elective courses to make a total of 108 credits for Upgrading students and 148 credits for fresh students. A bachelor Degree holder will take only 25 courses to earn the Bachelor Degree of Theology with Psychology

### **Instructions**

Is a program of study designed to provide knowledge, skills and understanding in Bible, Ministry, Theology, Management and Administration to church Ministers. In contemporary Christian there is a shortage of church leaders who possess skills knowledge in management and administration. This challenge has brought failure and decline of Church's projects and programs. Denominations are used unbelievers to run their Para church organizations and projects such as schools, hospitals companies and non government organizations (NGOs). Those unbeliever Managers, Directors and supervisors has corrupted and collapsed the Para church organizations. Many Para church organizations are led by non professional pastors or church ministers in management and leadership. Many Christian organizations have declined due to this reason.

Elam University (ECU) has formulated this curriculum in order to overcome these managerial challenges. This programme is intended to produce Church Leaders with Knowledge in Biblical, Theology and entrepreneurship who will help other Christian in training them in entrepreneurship.

## 55. PROGRAMS STRUCTURE

Programs of studies are divided into semester. Each semester consists of 15 weeks of studies. Within studies weeks on campus students attend the class where they meet with proffers and lecturers. Students engage in learning and teaching activities, in second semester students have 40 days for field practical, where by students practice what they have learned in the classroom. Field practice is supervised by lectures and practice coordinators.

Courses are weighed by instruction hours; the instruction hours are called credit (s) or unit (s). Each credit or unit consists of 15 hours of instruction. There course with 3 credits/units consists of 45 hours of instruction

## 56. TRANSFER OF CREDITS

Elam Christian University does accept credits transfer from other Accredited Bible colleges and Seminaries. Student who wishes to transfer credits will need to send copies of the transcripts showing courses, grades to vice Chancellor Academic

University Senate will evaluate the Transcripts or statement of Examinations Results. After evaluation the university senate will decide how many courses to be taken by students in particular program. An applicant should pay Credits assessment fee amount of Tsh, 50,000/= (\$30 for international Students)

## 57. DISTANCE LEARNING SYSTEM

### i. Learning description

Elam Christian University runs studies through face to face system and distance learning system (DLS). Distance Learning system is a learning system established to enable people to get education without coming to university campus. Students learn in their environment and in their own pace. Students interact with instructor through technology. Student do not need to come at the campus but they study while proceeding with their normal activities and ministries in their residences. Students get materials and examinations, they student to write exam and take another courses until they finish their study programs. Distance Learning system has two department which are online Department and Correspondence Department. Online and Correspondence Departments are the ones which form the distance learning system.

### ii. Study structure for distance Learning students

Online and correspondence students study at their own pace. Distance learning system is individual based learning which depend on individual understanding, economic capacity and availability of time.

So distance learning students do not have specific time of completion of studies. Every student finishes the studies at their own pace. Fast student can finish studies in short duration of time while slow student take a long time to finish the program. Student can not finish studies below the minimum time shown in particular program, also student can not finish the program beyond the maximum time shown in a particular program. Student who fails to complete the program on maximum time will be discontinued from the studies at this university.

### **iii. Enrolment for Distance Learning Students**

Elam Christian University have ongoing (progressive) enrollment for distance learning students. Distance Learning students are allowed to apply at any time when they wish to so. This is to say that distances learning applications are received any time. Online and correspondence students may begin studies at any time. This is a university without a wall. This is because distance learning students study at their own pace.

### **iv. Fee Payment Method**

Distance learning students pay tuition fee per course. This means that if student want to order 2 courses will pay a tuition fee of two courses, after studying those two courses will submit examinations and order another courses according to his financial capacity and arrangement of time for studying. Students are required to pay registration fee and quality assurance control before they begin studying at this university.

Distance learning Students can take up to four courses per month. It is recommended that students should take many courses as possible so that to use short time to finish the program. When distance Learning students spend more time in studying they do not reach their goals, many of them fail to complete the program of study. They lose interest of studying. Thus why we recommend them to spend short time to finish the program of study and achieve their goals. If student wants to order three courses will require to pay the fee amount of 3 courses.

### **v. Graduation System for Distance Learning Students**

After completing the studies in a particular program, students will be notified by the Deputy Vice Chancellor Academic through the Department Director. Students will be given a special form for Certificate Request. Student will fill it and submit to the department, after one month certificate will be issued. Before submitting the certificate request form student should pay a certificate fee according to the level of studies. Certificate fee vary from one level of study to another level.

It is not compulsory to attend the graduation ceremony for distance learning students. Students who wish to attend the graduation may request graduation application form which will be available to the Director of Department. Student is required to fill this form and show the centre which is planning to attend the graduation ceremony. Students is required to pay a graduation fee such as Graduation gown etc. student who wish to attend a graduation ceremony will be awarded his/her diploma/Degree certificate during the graduation ceremony.

## **58. DOCTRINAL STATEMENT**

1. We believe the Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, to be the verbal, plenary, inspired Word of God, without error in the original writings, the complete revelation of His will for the salvation of mankind, and the Divine and final authority for all Christian faith and practice.
2. . We believe in one God, Creator of all things, infinitely perfect, one in being, essence and power; yet eternally existing in three distinct persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe that Jesus Christ is true God and true man, having been conceived of the Holy Ghost and born of the Virgin Mary. He died on the cross a sacrifice for our sins according to the Scriptures. Further, He arose bodily from the dead and ascended into heaven, where, at the right hand of the Majesty on high, He now is our High Priest and Advocate.



4. We believe that the ministry of the Holy Spirit is to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ and during this age, to convict mankind, regenerate the believing sinner, and indwell, guide, instruct and empower the believer for godly living and service.
5. We believe that man and woman were created in the image of God but fell into sin. As a result, all human beings are born with a sinful human nature, and only through regeneration by the Holy Spirit can salvation and spiritual life be obtained.
6. We believe that the shed blood of Jesus Christ and His bodily resurrection provide the only ground for justification and salvation for all who believe.
7. We believe that water baptism and the Lord's Supper are ordinances to be observed by the church during this present age. They are, however, not to be regarded as means of salvation.
8. We believe that the true Church is composed of all such persons who through saving faith in Jesus Christ have been regenerated by the Holy Spirit and united together in the body of Christ of which He is the Head. Their sanctification, edification and security are provided for by the finished work of Christ.
9. We believe that Jesus Christ is the Lord and Head of the Church, and that every local church has the right, under Christ, to decide and govern its own affairs.
10. We believe in the personal, pre-millennial and imminent coming of our Lord Jesus Christ for the church, and in the subsequent, visible and premillennial return of Christ with His church to establish His kingdom on earth.
11. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the dead of the believer to everlasting blessedness and joy with the Lord and of the unbeliever to judgment and everlasting, conscious punishment.
12. We believe that Elam Christian Harvest Seminary (ECHASE) should have no relationships which would hinder its faculty from exposing apostasy, heresy or other sin. We stand separated unto God and from worldliness in personal behavior as well as corporate church programs.
13. We believe that all true believers in Christ are brothers and sisters in the family of God regardless of race or skin color. This unity is grounded in a common doctrinal foundation as well as the practical demonstration of love one to another.
